Also known by the name of its perpetrator, streptococcus pluton, european foulbrood is a bacterial disease plaguing innocent honey bee colonies across the globe. It can be recognized by the yellowing larvae which become twisted in their cell.

WANTED FOR: killing honey bee larvae

If found: european foulbrood is less dangerous than american foulbrood. It can be eliminated with antibiotics and /or feeding and requeening
